The excess space was given to a small bedroom closet, greatly increasing its functionality, and the bathroom has become a spa-like sanctuary where the homeowners love to spend time," said designer Michael Anschel. The room features river rock laid in a field of 4x4 tile to create a path that leads from the steam shower to the custom-built vanity. Remnant granite was used for the vanity top and the seat in the steam shower, with edges hand-drawn and cut to compliment the organic nature of the stone.

Residential Historical Renovation/Restoration

The homeowners had just purchased this 1912 Tudor style two-story and wanted to restore it to its former glory. Extensive structural repairs, stripping and refinishing of the painted woodwork, and layout changes to create a more functional and aesthetically pleasing space were just the beginning. The new kitchen design features a professional range, honed granite, and custom period cabinetry complete with a roll-out step under the sink to provide better access to upper cabinets. This home was not just restored; it was brought back to life.
